1. City of Fernandina Beach & Port Operations/Facilities:

BUDGET.

TOTAL HOURS – Septmeber 12, 2018 – October 5, 2018:

Including One Regular Meeting and One Special Meeting

TOTAL **31.500 Hours Hours in excess of ten (10) = 21.50**
 21.50 hours x \$250.00 = \$5,375.00 in addition to retainer

TOTAL HOURS – February 23, 2018 – October 5, 2018 [28.42 weeks] = 138.75 Hours

These figures cover 224 days, or approximately 7 1/2 months. [7.4666] For budget planning purposes, OHPA is consuming about 18.6 [18.582] hours of time per month, or about \$2,145.70 more than the monthly retainer. I believe that once we get a new port operating agreement and a new port master plan in place, with some measure of consistency between the two documents, then the pace may slow. Of course, there always seems to be “something” coming.
