RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R14 (AMENDED)

A RESOLUTION OF THE OCEAN HIGHWAY AND PORT AUTHORITY OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A POLICY PERTAINING TO OHPA EMPLOYMENT FOR PAST COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS the Ocean Highway and Port Authority ("OHPA") is an independent, special district created and chartered under the laws of the State of Florida at Chapter 2005-293, as authorized by F.S. Ch. 189.

WHEREAS OHPA has the obligation and responsibility to adopt ethics policies to ensure that Commissioners act with integrity that exceeds the minimum requirements of the law.

WHEREAS THE FLORIDA ETHICS LAWS CONTEMPLATE THAT LOCAL GOVERNMENTS SHOULD ADOPT POLICIES WHICH BOLSTER PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT, AND AID THE OHPA COMMISSION IN ACHIEVING ITS CHARTER PURPOSE, FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITIZENS OF NASSAU COUNTY AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

WHEREAS THE MINIMUM STANDARD REQUIRED BY LAW; A PERSON ELECTED TO COUNTY, MUNICIPAL, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR SPECIAL DISTRICT OFFICE IS PROHIBITED FROM REPRESENTING ANOTHER PERSON OR ENTITY FOR COMPENSATION BEFORE THE GOVERNMENT BODY OR AGENCY OF WHICH HE OR SHE WAS AN OFFICER FOR TWO YEARS AFTER LEAVING OFFICE. APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF COUNTIES, MUNICIPALITIES, SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND SPECIAL DISTRICTS MAY BE SUBJECT TO A SIMILAR RESTRICTION BY LOCAL ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION, [SEC. 112.313(13) AND (14), FLORIDA STATUTE].


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE OCEAN HIGHWAY AND PORT AUTHORITY, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. OHPA adopts the aforementioned Ethics standard and policy.


Section 2. This Resolution ~~shall be effective upon its adoption~~ shall apply to all OHPA elected officials that leave office after January 1, 2025.
