RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R01

A RESOLUTION OF THE OCEAN HIGHWAY AND PORT AUTHORITY, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA
APPOINTING A PORT DIRECTOR TO SERVE ON THE FLORIDA SEAPORT TRANSPORTATION AND
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL PURSUANT TO FLA. STAT. § 311.09; AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS Fla Stat. § 311.09 requires the Ocean Highway and Port Authority (hereinafter OHPA) to have a port director or a designee to serve on the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Council;

WHEREAS OHPA's former port director has resigned her position, and OHPA must appoint a port director to serve on the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Council;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE OCEAN HIGHWAY AND PORT AUTHORITY, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Christopher Ragucci shall serve as the port director for OHPA for purposes of serving on the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Council pursuant to Fla. Stat. § 311.09.


Section 2. The port director does not have any independent authority to obligate, bind, or contract for OHPA. Christopher Ragucci's role as port director role is limited to service on the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Council, as well as other customary marketing and advocacy on behalf of OHPA.

Section 3. The port director is not an employee of OHPA and will not receive any compensation for service on the Florida Seaport Transportation and Economic Development Council or serving as port director.

Section 4. This Resolution will become effective upon adoption.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Ocean Highway and Port Authority, Nassau County, Florida hereby adopts the foregoing Resolution, dated this 6th day of January, 2020.
