A RESOLUTION OF THE OCEAN HIGHWAY AND PORT AUTHORITY OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA
TO PRESERVE THE CUSTOMS HOUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Ocean Highway and Port Authority currently provides office space for Customs and Border Protection in the structure known as the Customs House located at 403 N 3rd St in Fernandina Beach.

WHEREAS, OHPA must provide new office space for CBP, and CBP will vacate the customs house.

WHEREAS, the City of Fernandina Beach has expressed a desire for the Customs House to be preserved due to the City's view of it as a historical structure.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE OCEAN HIGHWAY AND PORT AUTHORITY, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:


Section 1. OHPA will make reasonable efforts to preserve the Customs House after CBP vacates it. These efforts may include moving the Customs House to a different parcel of property that OHPA owns.

Section 2. If OHPA determines that it does not have the practicable ability to preserve the Customs House, OHPA will offer the structure to the City of Fernandina Beach and give the City a reasonable time to remove the structure from OHPA's property.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.


